How to Change a Flight Booked Through Chase Travel

Step 1: Check Your Fare Rules First

Before calling anyone, log into Chase Travel and review your ticket details. Look closely at your fare type, such as Basic Economy, Main Cabin, or Business Class. 1-855-546-5045

Basic Economy fares usually cannot be changed.

Main Cabin and higher fares often allow changes, sometimes without a fee.
