Key Rule to Know Before Canceling

Chase Travel does not determine whether a ticket is refundable. Airline fare rules control refunds, credits, and fees.

Five Actionable Steps to Cancel a Chase Travel Flight

Step 1: Log Into Your Chase Travel Account

Visit [chase.com](https://chase.com), go to Travel, then My Trips, and locate your booking.

Example: A Sapphire Preferred cardholder logs in and finds a Delta booking.

Step 2: Review Airline Fare Rules

Check if the ticket is refundable, non-refundable with credit, or subject to fees.

Example: A United non-refundable ticket allows cancellation for future credit minus a fee.

Step 3: Attempt Online Cancellation

Many eligible tickets can be canceled directly through Chase Travel.

Example: A JetBlue flight was canceled online without calling support.

Step 4: Contact Chase Travel Support If Required

Some bookings require agent assistance due to airline restrictions or changes. 1-855-546-5045
